***Position: General Counsel Support Division (GCSD)-Air (Air Legal Support Office (LSO))***

***Unit: HQ-DCANG***

***Area of Consideration:*** Open to current members of the District of Columbia Air National Guard (DCANG) and Air National Guard (ANG) members eligible for membership in the DCANG.

***Job Summary:***

The Director of NGB GCSD–Air/Air LSO serves as the senior leader responsible for delivering premier legal analysis and counsel to the National Guard Bureau Office of the General Counsel, the DC Air National Guard, and, when appropriate, the Air National Guard nationwide. The role provides continuous legal support in Domestic Operations, Procurement, Fiscal, and Administrative Law, and contributes to NGB-GC strategic initiatives across all 54 States and Territories.

The Director also serves as an adjunct member of the ANG Judge Advocate Council, participating in recurring in-person and virtual engagements. The Director leads a unit of seven attorneys and a paralegal, providing strategic vision, mentorship, and oversight to ensure readiness, professional excellence, and a positive command climate grounded in dignity, respect, and continuous development.

***Requirements:***

- Rank eligibility: Judge Advocates in the rank of Colonel (O6), or Lieutenant Colonel (O5) who will be eligible for promotion to Colonel (O6) before 31 December 2026.
- Completion of Air War College is required to obtain O-6.
- ANG Drill Status Guardsmen (DSG) Judge Advocates in the DC Air National Guard.

***Duties and Responsibilities:***

- Serve as Director of GCSD–Air/Air LSO to ensure delivery of preeminent legal analysis and advice to the NGB Office of the General Counsel (NGB-GC), the DCANG, and when able and asked, the ANG.
- Provide seamless and ready support staff to assist NGB-GC/DCANG operations including at the National Guard Joint Operations Center (JOC) and the DCNG JOC during domestic operational exercises, Presidential-declared emergencies, and special events.
- Provide year-round expert legal support to NGB-GC and the DCNG in Domestic Operational, Procurement, Fiscal, and Administrative Law.
- Ensure year-round support to NGB-GC strategic missions in support of the ANG JAG

community in the 54 States and Territories.

- Serve as an adjunct member of the ANG JA Council, which includes attending all in-person ANG JA Council meetings that occur every 2-3 months at various locations in-CONUS, and more frequent telephonic/virtual meetings as required.

**Expectations:**

- Must display an attitude/philosophy of professionalism, leadership, coaching/mentoring skills, quality management practices, and be focused on people.
- Must be willing to travel at least quarterly for 3-5 days at a time as an adjunct member of the ANG JA Council.

**Experience:**

Diverse professional experience through JA assignments in the Air Force and Air National Guard.
