**AREA OF CONSIDERATION:**

All members who meet the requirements for entry into the District of Columbia Air National Guard.

**DUTIES:**

The Warfighter Communications Operations Officer plans, design, secures, and operates military information networks and cyberspace infrastructure to support battlefield commanders. They provide critical cyber-related expertise, manage defensive cyberspace operations, and ensure secure, reliable communications (DODIN Operations) in both garrison and deployed environments.

- Cyberspace Operations Management: Operates, secures, and sustains Department of Defense information network (DODIN) systems.
- Mission Assurance: Develops and implements Primary, Alternate, Contingency, and Emergency (PACE) communications plans.
- Operational Support: Translates operational requirements into technical solutions for air, space, and cyber missions.
- Defensive Cyber Operations (DCO): Protects, defends, and preserves network capabilities against intrusions.
- Leadership: Leads, trains, and manages crews in cyber-related activities.

**QUALIFICATIONS:**

1. A background in information technology operations or cybersecurity is preferred.
2. Be a current member of the DCANG or eligible to join.
3. The ability to obtain a TS/SCI security clearance.
